To apply for a new or renewal CHL You must first go online at <https://www.texasonline.state.tx.us/txapp/txdps/chl/>.

Online you will fill in the application form and three affidavits. You will also pay, by credit card, the state fee for your application. The state fee varies. See the last page of this packet for the complete list.

Once completed you will receive a receipt that you must print and bring to class.

NEW APPLICANTS ONLY: After you complete the online application you must go to <http://www.ibtfingerprint.com/locations/?st=tx> to make an appointment with L1 Identity Services to have your fingerprints taken. You can do this before you take the class or after. You must have your receipt from the online application process in order to schedule with L1.

RENEWAL APPLICANTS DO NOT NEED TO HAVE FINGER PRINTS NOR PHOTOS TAKEN.

Renewal students may not take this class more than 180 days prior to the expiration date on their license.

- 1. START TIME:**
NEW APPLICANTS: 7:00 AM
RENEWAL APPLICANTS: 11:00 AM.
- 2. TRAINING LOCATION:** Classroom: At National Slingshot Corp., 5288 East FM 552, **Royse City**, TX 75189 (see map below). Shooting qualification will be conducted at the Ammo Depot, (see map below).
- 3. FEES: There are two fees:**

Academic/Range Qualification Fee, is paid to the instructor as follows:

If you ARE a member of Majors Gun Club: new = \$65 renewal = \$45

If you ARE NOT a member of Majors Gun Club: new = \$80 renewal = \$60

This fee includes all required academic training, photographs, and range qualification as required.

State License Fee, The state fee varies. There are discounts for age, veteran status and other conditions. **A COMPLETE STATE LICENSE FEE LIST IS ON THE LAST PAGE OF THIS PACKET.**

- 4.** We will have a working lunch starting at 12:00 noon in one of the nearby restaurants. (students pay for themselves.).

5. We will go to the range at approximately 4:00 PM for the shooting qualification – rain or shine, hot or cold. Watch the weather reports and wear appropriate clothing and footwear. It will be muddy if it rains.
6. Students need to bring eye and ear protection. I have limited resources if you need some.
7. **.32** is the minimum caliber with which to qualify. Recommend you qualify with a semi-automatic handgun (SA) so you can carry either a revolver (NSA) or an SA handgun. If you qualify with a revolver (NSA) you will not be allowed to carry a semi-automatic handgun. I have SA handguns to use if you do not have one.
8. Each student will shoot 50 rounds of **FULL METAL JACKET** factory ammunition - no reloaded ammunition. Ammunition can be purchased at the Ammo Depot. Leave your handgun and ammunition in your car until instructed otherwise. **IF YOU HAVE MORE THAN ONE MAGAZINE, BRING IT WITH YOU.**
9. **Range etiquette** – bring a plastic bag - you will be required to pick up your spent casings after the shooting qualification.
10. **Liability Waivers and Affirmation of Training:** Review the attached liability waivers and the affirmation of training. Take them to a lawyer if you do not understand them. You must sign all three documents. Relatives should not sign as a witness on these forms.
11. Bring a picture ID (driver's license or government issued ID). If you are an L3 Employee, bring your E-Club card and Majors Gun Club card if you are a member of either or both.

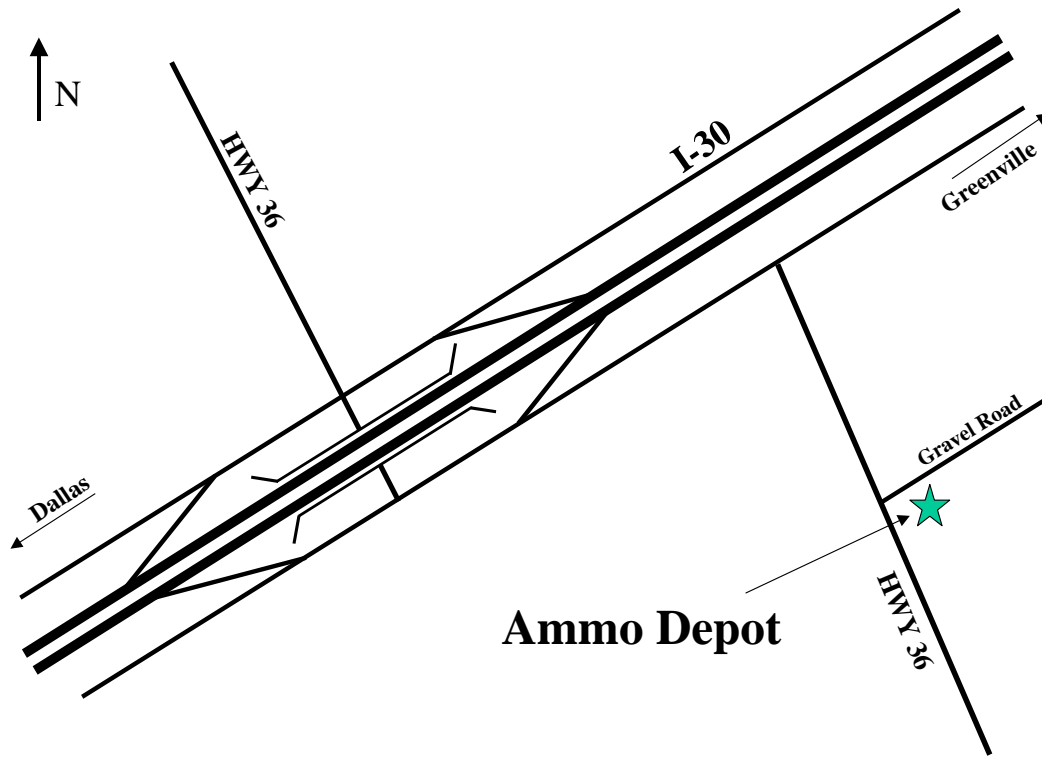
Classroom topics

1. Legal Aspects of Concealed Carry
2. Non-Violent Dispute Resolution
3. Safe handling & Storage of Firearms
4. Basic Handgun Marksmanship
5. Use of Force and Deadly Force

NOTE: Basic firearm training is NOT provided. You should already have a fundamental working knowledge of topics 3 and 4. Topics 3 and 4 are provided as refresher material and to establish rules and procedures for safely and successfully completing the range qualification.

At the end of the academic training you will take a 50 question (multiple choice - true/false) test on which you must attain a minimum score of 70 out of a possible 100.

**Range qualification will be conducted at the Ammo Depot, 4725 FM 36 South #2

You will shoot 50 rounds of factory loaded, full metal jacket ammunition. Neither hollow-point nor reloaded ammunition is permitted. Your handgun ammunition will be inspected. As a safety factor for you and the other students, the final decision as to the use of any particular handgun or ammunition will be at the instructor's discretion.

Bring your **UNLOADED** handgun to the range either holstered or in a closed case.

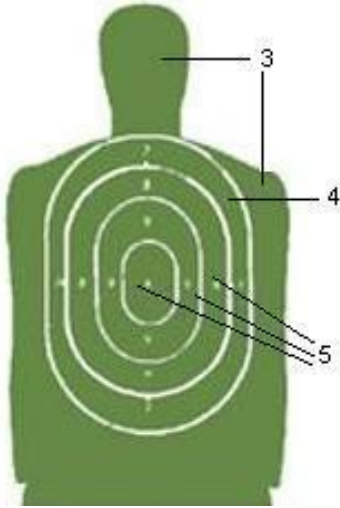
The three critical firearm safety rules are:

1. Always keep your firearm pointed in a safe direction (toward the target).
2. Always keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot.
3. Always keep your firearm unloaded until ready to shoot.

Violation of safety procedures is cause for disqualification.

You will be shooting at the B27 target. You must attain a score of 175 out of a possible 250 to pass this part of the training. A score sheet and the Range Qualification Course of Fire are on the following pages.

If you do not attain a passing score, you may immediately retake the ENTIRE range qualification course of fire. If after **two** complete qualification attempts you still have not attained a passing score, you will have to return at a later date and repeat the entire range qualification training.

Range Qualification

Course of Fire

From a distance of 3 yards, 20 Rounds:

5 rounds, “one shot exercise”, 2 seconds for each shot

10 rounds, “two shot exercise”, 3 seconds for each 2 shots

5 rounds in 10 seconds

From a distance of 7 yards, 20 rounds:

5 rounds in 10 seconds

5 rounds in 2 stages:

2 shots in 4 seconds

3 shots in 6 seconds

5 rounds, “one shot exercise”, 3 seconds for each shot

5 rounds in 15 seconds

From a distance of 15 yards, 10 rounds:

5 rounds in 2 stages

2 shots in 6 seconds

3 shots in 9 seconds

5 rounds in 15 seconds

If you are pregnant:

Range qualification involves the use of lead in an extremely high noise environment (125 – 150 dB.)

Recommend you seek medical advice before you participate in this training.

Range Qualification Instructions

Range qualification will begin at the 3 yard line with all handguns in the “safe” condition; for semi-automatics the safe condition is lying down ejection port up, magazine out and slide locked back; for revolvers, lying down, cylinders open and empty.

For each string of fire you will be instructed as to the number of rounds to load and the string of fire to follow. For semi-automatics, load your magazine and hold it up in your hand so the instructor can see you are ready. Do not put the magazine in the gun until instructed to do so. For revolvers, load the cylinders but do not close. While keeping the revolver pointed downrange, hold up your empty hand.

You will then be commanded to get into the firing position. For semi-automatics, while keeping the muzzle pointed downrange, insert the magazine into your handgun and load a round into the chamber. For revolvers, keeping the muzzle pointed downrange, close the cylinder. Take your normal shooting position and stand fast, pointing your handgun toward the target **WITH YOU FINGER OUTSIDE THE TRIGGER GUARD**. Pointing your handgun in any direction other than downrange is cause for disqualification.

The string of fire will be announced once more and “is the line ready,” will be asked. If the line is ready the next command you receive will be “FIRE.”

At the end of the allotted time for each string the command “STOP” will be given. You must immediately stop firing and put your handgun in the “Safe” condition. If you complete the string of fire before time ends, put your gun in the “Safe” condition and stand fast on the firing line.

If you have a malfunction, keep the muzzle pointed toward the target, clear it and continue shooting – time will not stop for you. If you do not get all your shots off you will not be given extra time. In a real life situation you won’t get a second chance.

If you cannot clear a malfunction, stand fast; keep the muzzle pointed at the target and hold up one hand. The instructor will assist you.

Notify the instructor if you drop any ammunition, **DO NOT PICK IT UP**.

DO NOT go forward of the firing line.

ANYONE observing an unsafe condition on the range should raise an alert by shouting “STOP, STOP, STOP.” At that point all shooters should stand fast, keep their handguns pointed at the target and await further commands from the instructor.

At the end of the qualification exercise, put your handgun in the “safe” condition and place it back into its carrying case.

Range etiquette is an important part of your training. Bring a plastic bag with you. After all handguns are made safe and put away, all students will pick up fifty spent casings. Caliber does not matter, any fifty casings will get you a passing score in range etiquette.

 - Proper storage practices for handguns with an emphasis on storage practices that eliminate the possibility of accidental injury to a child.

Undersigned affirms that this instruction included the successful completion of a written examination prescribed by the Texas Department of Public Safety, and administered by the Instructor, results of which are maintained on file with the instructor for a period of three (3) years following completion of training.

Undersigned affirms that a passing score on the Range Proficiency Test conducted in accordance with Texas Administrative Code, Title 37, Part 1, Chapter 6(B), Rule Section 6.11 and Chapter 6(G) Rule Section 6.77 was achieved, proof of which is maintained on file with the instructor for a period of three (3) years following completion of the proficiency test.
